# What to bring:


- Your passports— which you will have to look after yourselves. We have been asked to bring them with us when we go to CERN, so please ensure you have somewhere on you to keep them safe.
- Your European Health Card we will go to France to visit experiments.
- Some Swiss francs for souvenirs etc. All meals are provided: London students will be provided with a kitty of cash for lunch and dinner at CERN and may require you to collect a receipt for what you spend from the CERN cafeteria.
- Dress code: Casual Clothes for cool/warm/wet weather (check the weather forecast!). We will be walking outside for various periods of time at CERN and around Geneva.
- Closed toe sensible shoes required for experimental visits
- A towel (or you can borrow one from the Youth Hostel for 2 CHF)
- Don't forget your Oyster cards to get to the airport (with enough money on!)
- Something to write with and on.
- Your cameras / anything else you want to bring.
- Luggage: Please note that while we have 20kg allowance for the hold, please ensure you have any
  essentials in your hand-luggage in case bags suffer the same fate as on the last trip (delayed for 2 days
   unlikely but best to be prepared). Remember, in your hand baggage you can take no containers that

- Medicines, plus a copy of any prescriptions. Customs officials may want to verify that a container's contents match its label, so all medication should be carried in their original containers.


Note: In the hostel you will have a locker in which to lock your valuables.
